- 1. Meeting Minutes: N. Wilson (1st), T. DeCarli (2nd), All in favor
- 2. President's Report (J. Bourque): The season is off to a good start.
 - **a. Future meetings:** We will try to do future board meetings at LMS to be more productive with less distractions and more space for our members to sit and be a part of discussion.
- Treasurer's Report (M. Duprey): Nothing to report. S. Smith will check with Maggie before future meetings to see if she can provide us with a brief update/run down to share with the group.
- 4. Equipment Coordinator Update (T. DeCarli):
 - a. **Recent uniform bulk order** (S. Brown): S. Brown suggested that perhaps future orders should be done by each parent rather than a bulk order to make the process more efficient and less chasing for those organizing. It will then be the responsibility of each parent to order their players uniform.
 - i. T. DeCarli mentioned that we can do this in the future but we did it bulk order this time to help with the discount of the uniform order.
 - b. Rec shirts: Due to recent requests, T. DeCarli will order additional smaller sized shirts: (i.e.: Instructional: more XS and Small 4v4: more Youth Small and Youth Medium)

 - **ii. Benches:** Random big thing to be missing but there is a bench missing at Sawmill and from now on coaches need to take benches out of shed and put them away with the corner flags after each game (if the last game being played).
 - iii. Sandbags: B. Bourque has requested that we remind everyone, all coaches, etc to be gentle with the sandbags on the nets. These are newly purchased and are intended to keep the goals from tipping over. Looks like some of the bags have already been damaged.

 - **b. Terri:** Need to order 16 red Litchfield T's [information on sizing to follow by Karl this Saturday]
 - **c. Brian:** need to confirm if Field 3 Shed End, still has openings for any Saturday games 9/15 or 9/22 I may be able to schedule after 10:15.

- **d. Refs:** Running low on refs and K. Reinert knows a ref that would like to do some games in Litchfield to help with any holes in the schedule that is not covered.
