## c. Senior Rec Update (K. Schoff):

 Karl has completed the Senior rec portion of the LYSL season here is his summary:

"We were able to accomplish 3 cross town scrimmages even with a bare bones team. What started out as 12 registered players averaged 10-11 by mid-season due to illness and other scholastic commitments by some players. I've enjoyed coaching for nearly Senior Rec., however, my father's struggles with his failing mental health and his short term memory loss and dementia are calling me to attend to his needs.

I'm including an outreach by a previous player / parent below, I have not responded to her, nor have I told any of my current parents or players about my resigning from coaching Senior Rec. It's instances like Devin's or reflecting on others thru the years like helping youths with ailments, ADD or Asperger's syndrome, etc. that pull at my heart and senses. It pains me to have to give up this position, the coaching and the life lessons I love to instill and pass on to the kids.

I may send a follow-up email later in the summer to let parent's know of my departure, but in good faith I'd like to do so knowing there's a plan in place.

My agenda item is to ask the board to try really hard, and to succeed, in finding a person or persons with passion, discipline, drive and compassion to offer to teach and coach those young boys and girls who want to participate in the Senior Rec. Soccer program in the Fall and in the coming years. Only prerequisite, their commitment to

helping those kids become young men & women and leaders in our community. Call it my swan song, but that's what I respectfully ask of you the LYSL board."
